Call for papers

The 1st ICC Conference on **Network Modeling and Economic Systems** will be held in Lisbon, **October 9-11, 2008**, as part of the Institute for Complexity Science (ICC) activities. The Institute for Complexity Sciences supports research in Complexity domains, promoting knowledge in interdisciplinary subjects.

The program will consist primarily of contributed papers. The program committee will be chaired by João Ferreira do Amaral of the Research Unit on Complexity and Economics (UECE) and Instituto Superior de Economia e Gestão (ISEG) of the Technical University of Lisbon.

The ICC-NMES conference includes a **Special Session on Applications**: while the main part of ICC-NMES is methodologically oriented, this half-day session focuses on applications to various areas of economics: primarily, the structure and formation of R&D collaboration networks are focused on, but also contributions from other areas, such as techno-economic networks, innovation networks, social capital, and finance are welcome.

Submitted abstracts should not be over 300 words in length. Abstracts should represent original manuscripts not previously presented. The following information should also be provided electronically at the time of submission: the authors' names, affiliations, complete addresses, telephone and fax numbers; both the email addresses and web sites (if any) of the submitters; the JEL primary field name and number; and the paper title.
